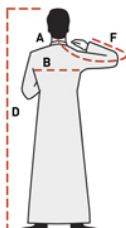

- For accurate results, please have your measurements taken by another person.
 For a free measuring tape and wall chart for measuring height, please Quick Order product 11008.
- A NECK** Wrap a tape measure around the base of your neck, where a shirt collar would close. Inches, to the next half inch = size.
 - B CHEST** Measure around fullest part of chest keeping tape under arms and around shoulder blades. Measure "loosely", with a couple of fingers under the tape. Inches = size.
 - D HEIGHT** Stand in stocking feet with heels and back against wall. Mark height on wall and measure from mark to floor. Inches = height.
 - F ARM** Measure from center back of neck, over shoulder to wrist bone. Inches = size.
